Inclusion activities at each school are now in full swing. Students at Fulton Elementary are participating in a pen pal program, several students from CLS ES are joining FES classes. Students from FES joined the CLS ES winter program. A total of 63 Lime Kiln MS students signed up to be peer buddies to CLS MS students for the spring term. Groups of students have planned activities twice a day, five days a week. In addition, about one-quarter of the CLS MS students continue to participate in activities with LKMS students weekly in classes and other activities. Several classes joined the CLS MS at their Winter Program. During the second quarter, two high school students regularly attended a class at Reservoir HS, while two more students participated twice a month in a class project. One high school class has begun eating lunch at RHS once a week and three students have been matched with a Best Buddy for after-school activities. The most fun was club advisory day, when students from CLS HS went to Star Wars Club, Guitar Jam and weightlifting. A third bus has been added to help with transporting students between CLS and FES/ RHS.
