The Summer Transportation Institute will be held on the campus of Morgan State University from July 2, 2010 to July 30, 2010.

The Summer Transportation Institute is a free program that introduces and exposes students to career opportunities in the transportation industry.~ The program offers four weeks of field trips, hands-on projects and networking opportunities with transportation industry professionals.~ In addition, the curriculum prepares students for high education by providing SAT preparation, financial planning and time management workshops.

Although the Summer Transportation Institute is a free program, it only accepts twenty students.~ Selected students will receive a full scholarship that covers all program expenses including lab fees and field trips.~ Lunch and bus passes are provided daily and each student receives a \$250 stipend upon completion of the program.
