Fact Fishing

Addition Doubles

1. Up to 4 players can play this game. Players are dealt 7 cards.
2. The rest of the cards are left in a stack.
3. Use pairs of cards **to make doubles**. If you have a double, you must say it in an addition sentence. With two 8's you would say $8 + 8 = 16$. If the fact is not correct, one of the cards must be returned to the bottom of the stack and a new one selected from the top of the stack.
4. If a double cannot be made, ask your opponent for a specific card. If they do not have that card, you "fish" a card off of the top of the stack. One card is then returned to the bottom of the stack.
5. Take turns until one player has no cards left.



Example

In this example, a player could say $8 + 8 = 16$ to make a pair.

However, the player would then have no other doubles facts and would need to "fish".
