# Fact Fishing

## Addition Make Ten

1. Up to four players can play this game. Players are dealt 7 cards.
2. The rest of the cards are left in a stack.
3. Use pairs of cards **to make ten**.
4. If a 10 sum cannot be made, ask your opponent for a specific card. If they do not have that card, you "fish" a card off of the stack. One card is then returned to the bottom of the stack.
5. Take turns until one player has no cards left.
6. The player with the most sums wins.



In this example, a player could make the ten with an 8 and a 2.

However, the player would then have no cards to make ten and would have to go "fish".
