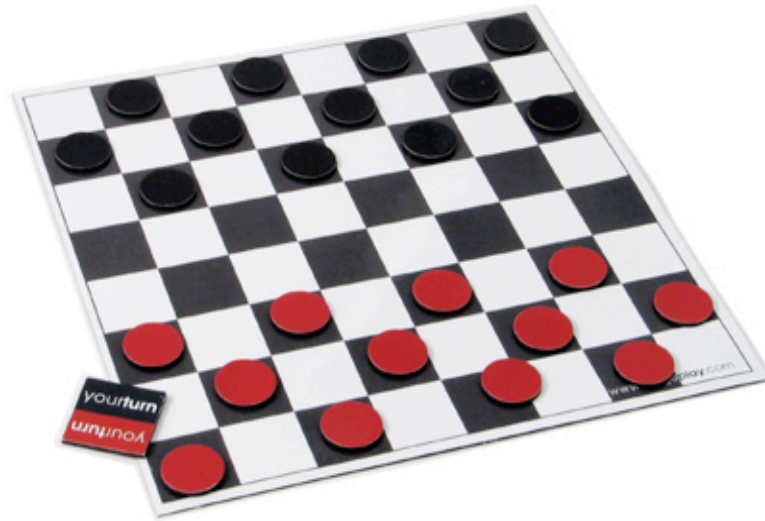


MATH CHECKERS



MATERIALS:

Two different kinds of markers like blocks, beans, or small counters.

DIRECTIONS:
